ORDER – CRUELLY TREATED ANIMAL CASE

On JUNE 3, 2021, the court heard this case. Having heard all evidence and considered all pleadings on file, the court **FINDS** that the owner(s), Jorge and San Juanita Padilla, of the animal(s) described as 138 head of cattle:

- Did not cruelly treat the animal(s). It is therefore **ORDERED** that the animal(s) be returned to the owner(s).
- Did cruelly treat the animal(s) unreasonably depriving the cattle necessary food, care or shelter (describe the cruel treatment). It is therefore **ORDERED** that the owner(s) be divested of ownership of the animal(s) described above.

It is further **ORDERED** that, **not before the 10th day after this order is signed**, the animal(s) described above be (choose one):

- Sold by public auction, with the proceeds from the sale to be first applied to the costs ordered below.
 - Optional*: It is further **ORDERED** that the animal(s) be spayed or neutered at the cost of the receiving party.
- Given to the following municipal or county animal shelter or nonprofit animal welfare organization: _____
 - Optional*: It is further **ORDERED** that the animal(s) be spayed or neutered at the cost of the receiving party.
- Humanely destroyed, because the court **FINDS** that doing so is in the best interest of the animal or best serves the public health and safety.

It is further **ORDERED** that the owner(s) pay costs in the amount of \$ 36,244⁰⁰.

The animal owner(s) have the right to appeal this Order to the **County** Court of Goliad County, Texas. The court **FINDS** that the estimated costs likely to be incurred to house and care for the impounded animal during the appeal process is \$ 36,244⁹³. It is therefore **ORDERED** that the amount of bond necessary to perfect an appeal is \$ 72,489⁹⁶ / X (the sum of the costs ordered above plus the costs likely to be incurred during the appeal process).
