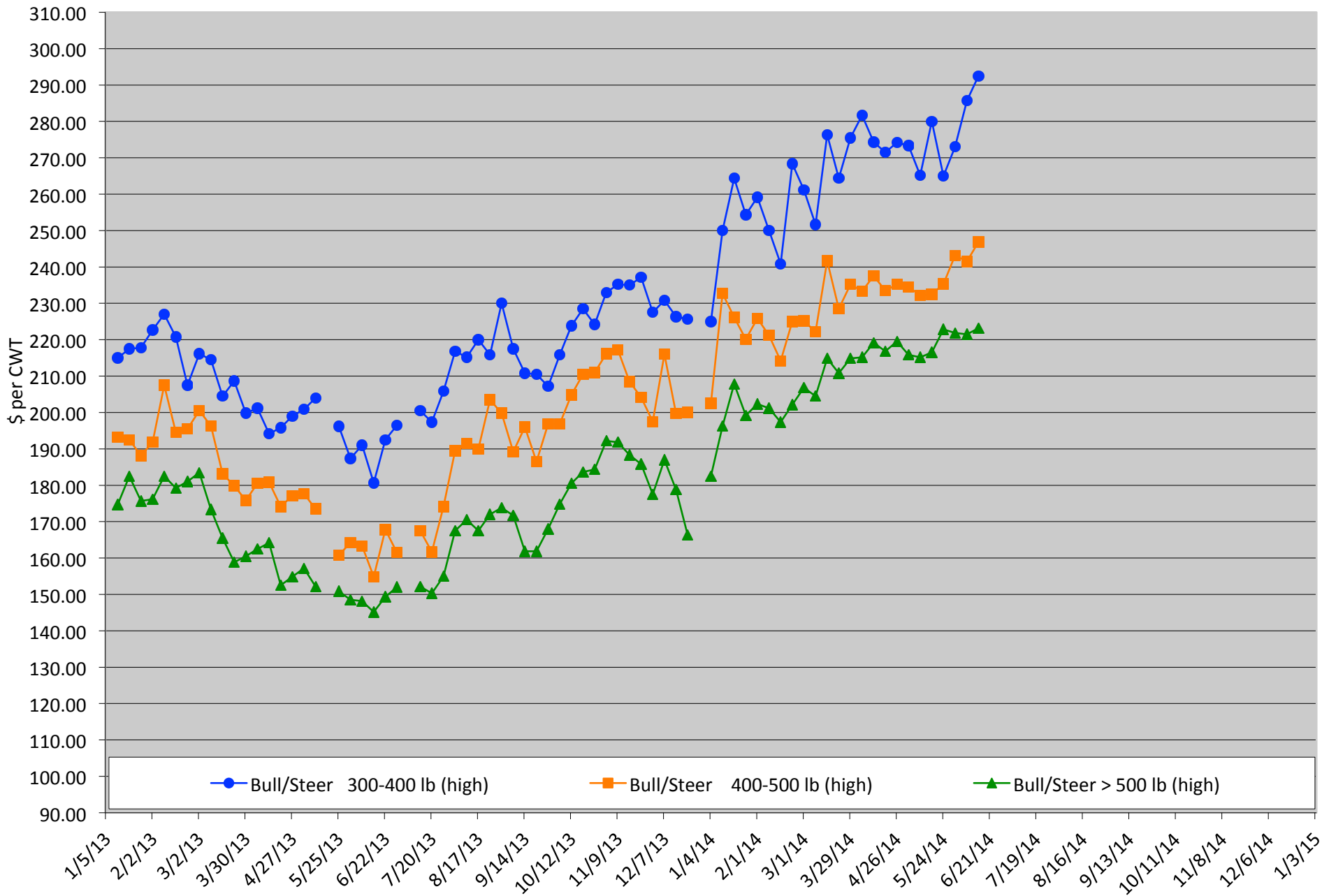

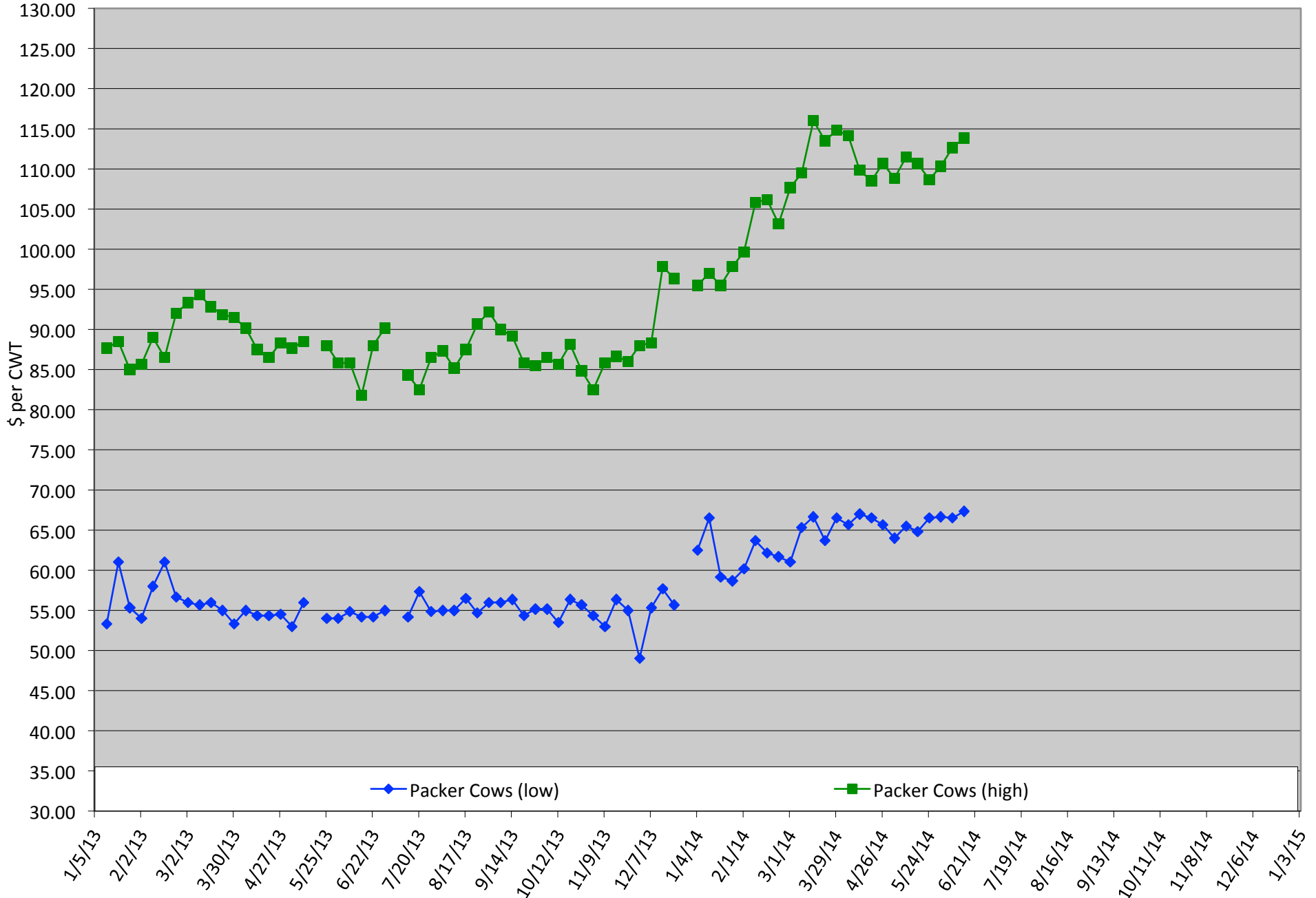


# Packer Cow PriceTrends

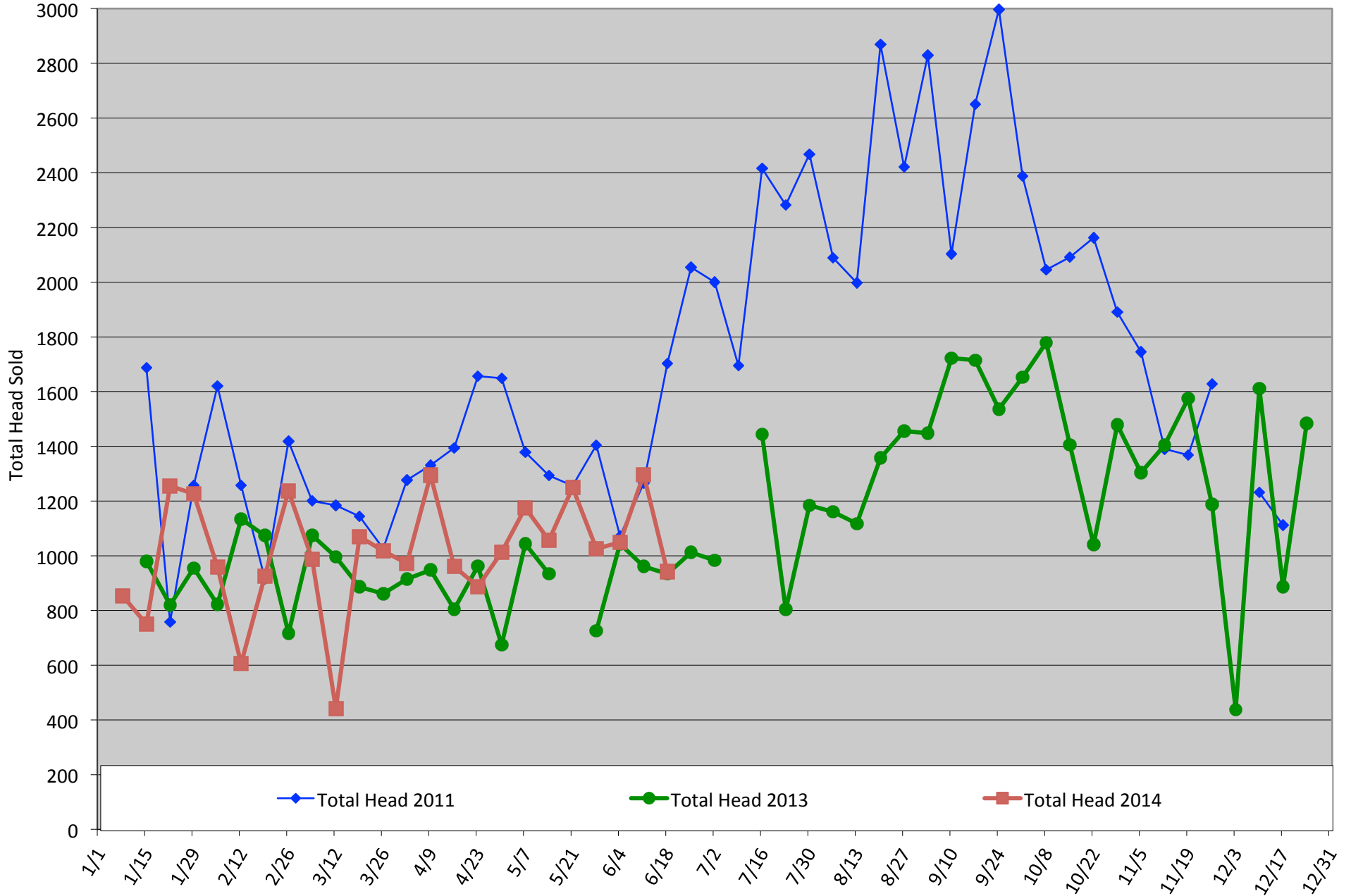


# Total Head Sold Trends

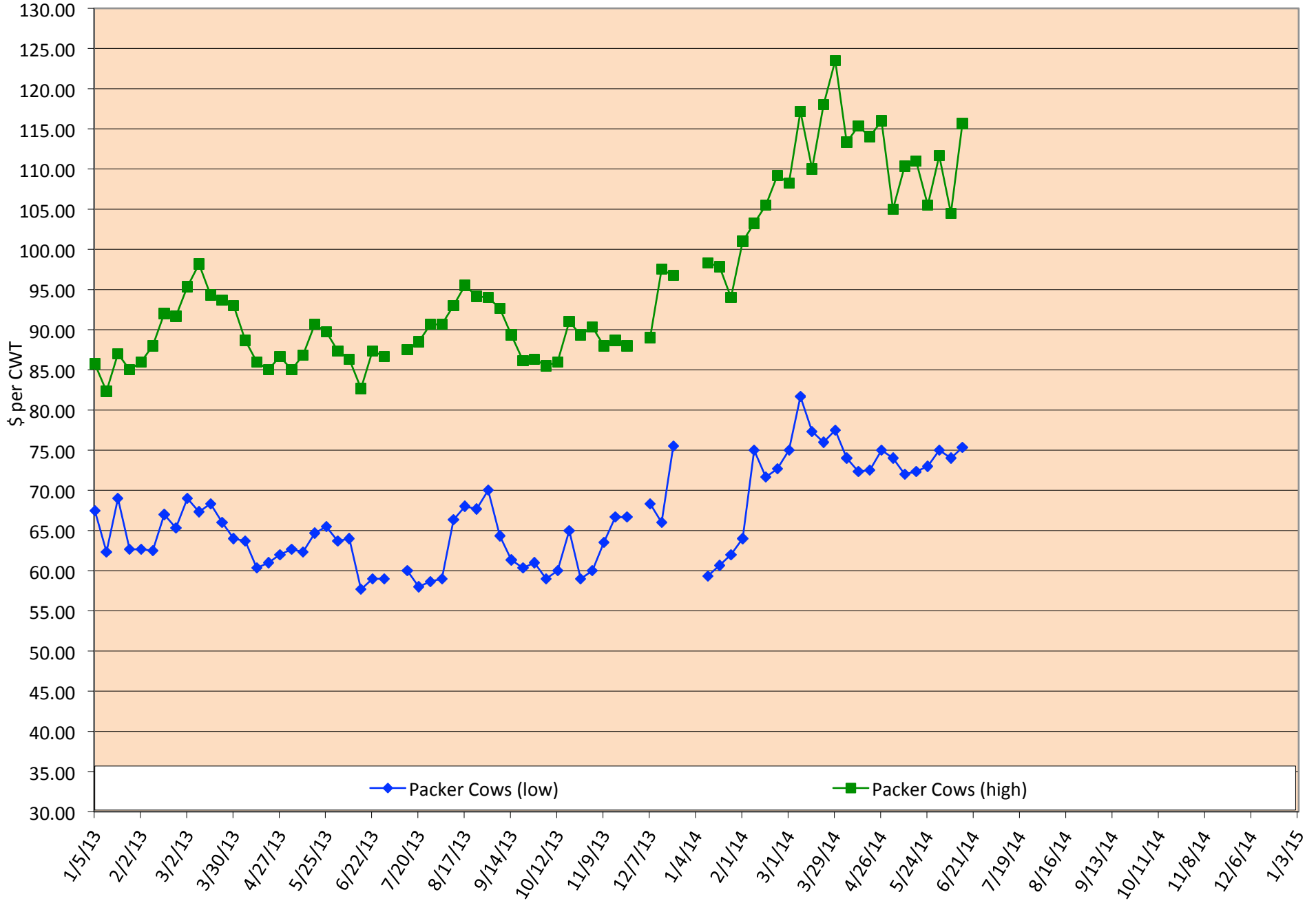


# Packer Cow Price Trends
