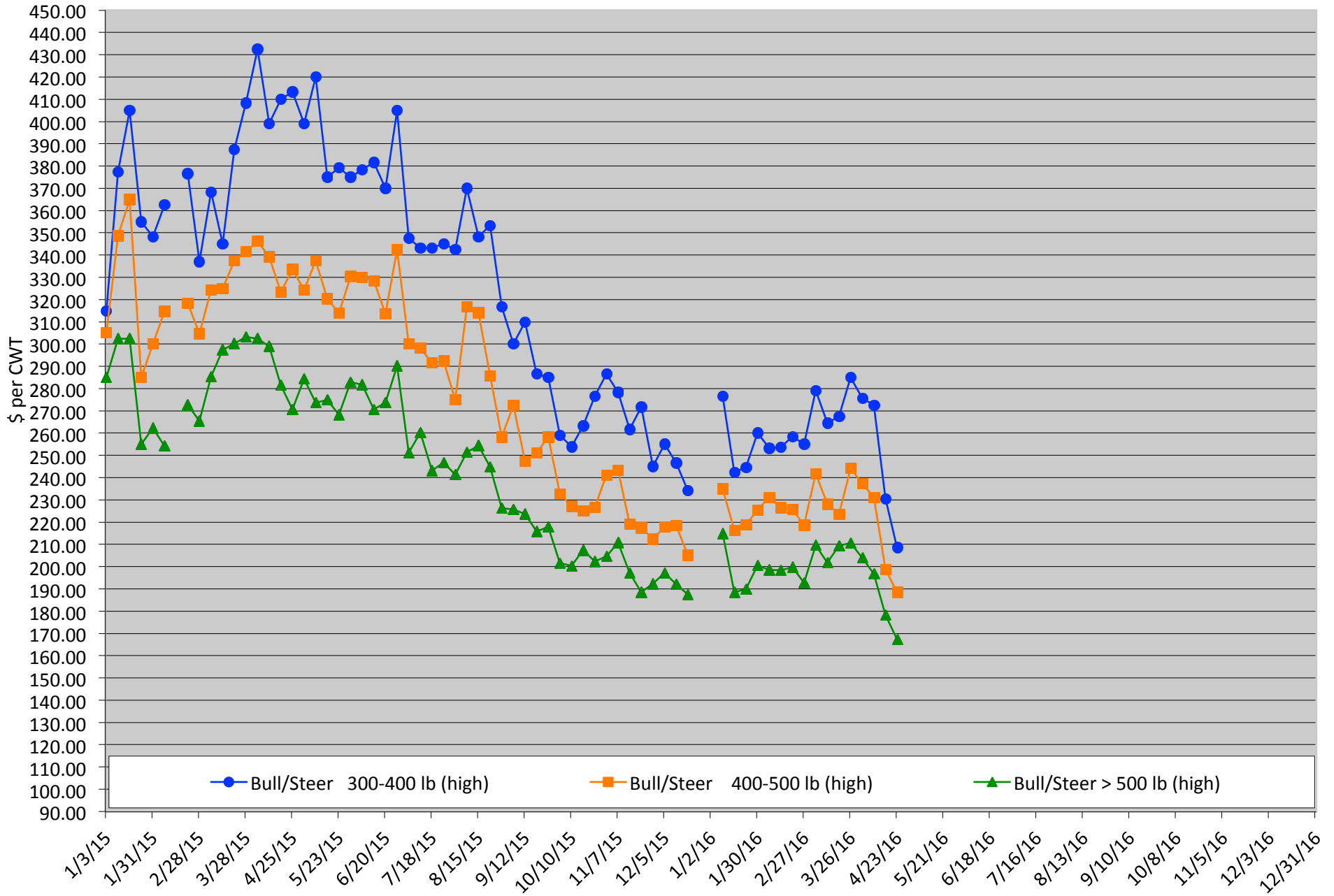

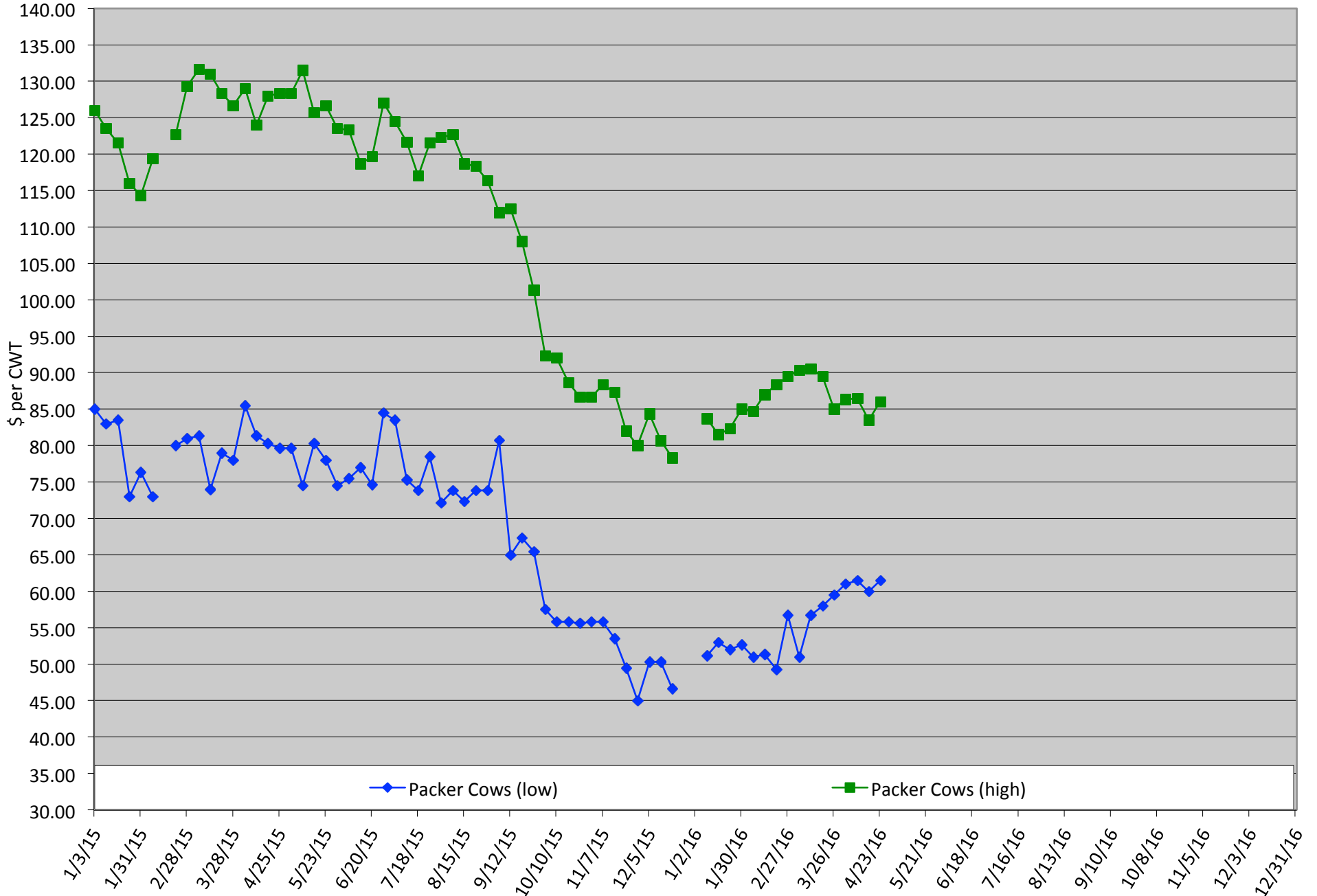


# Packer Cow Price Trends

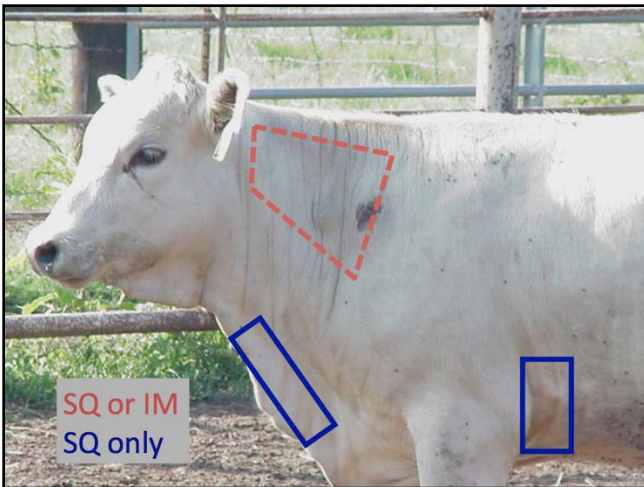

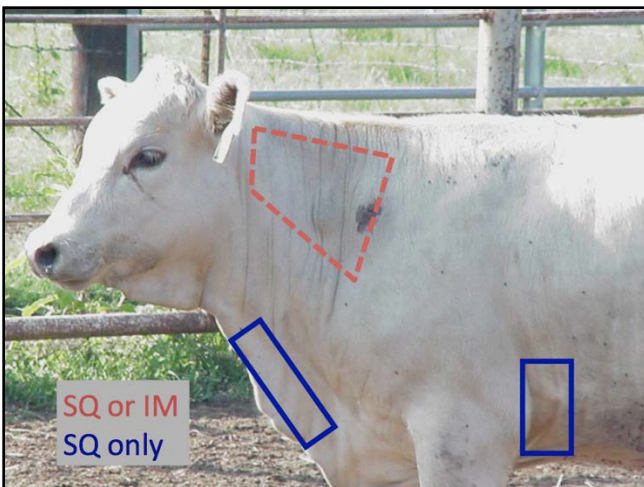

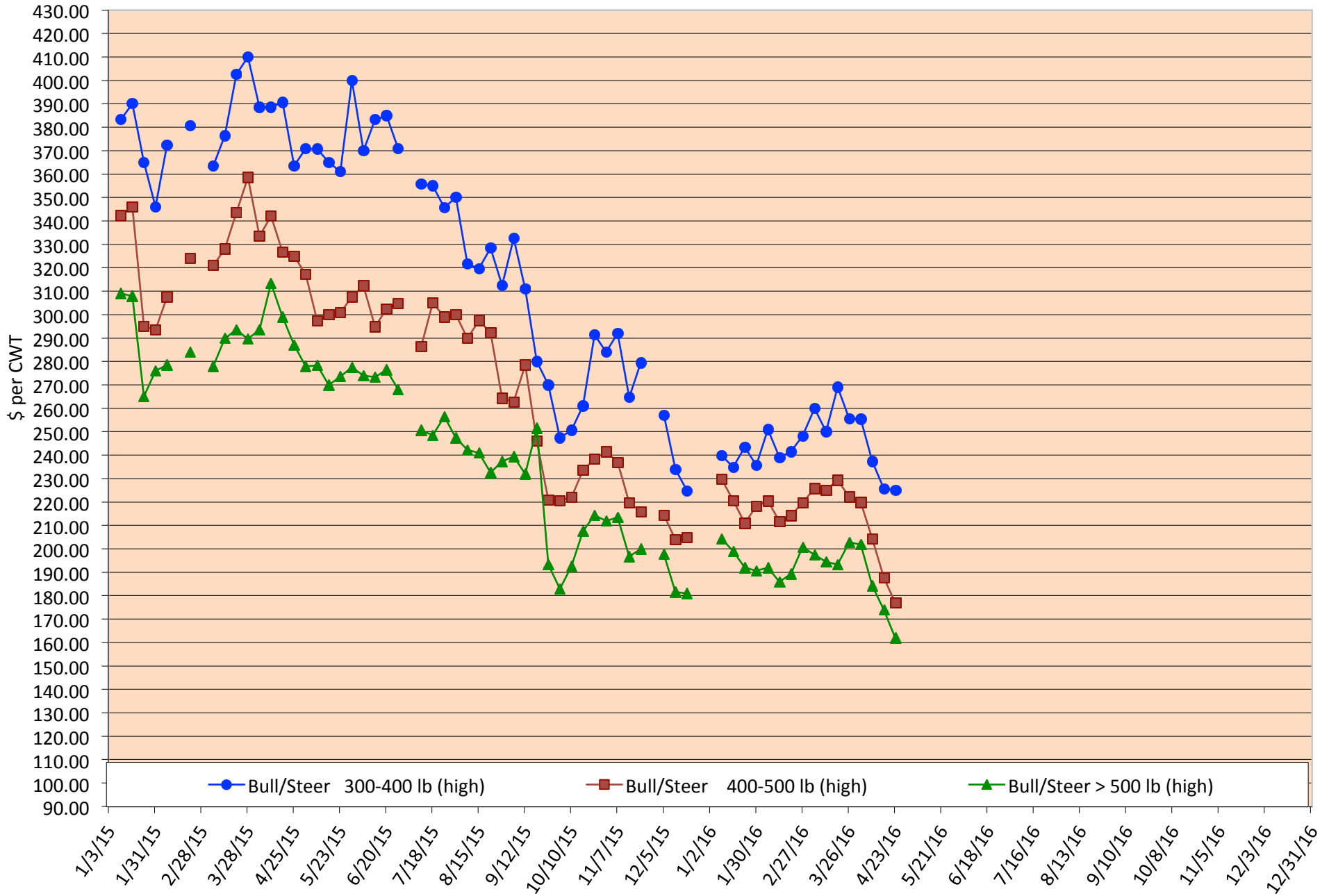
