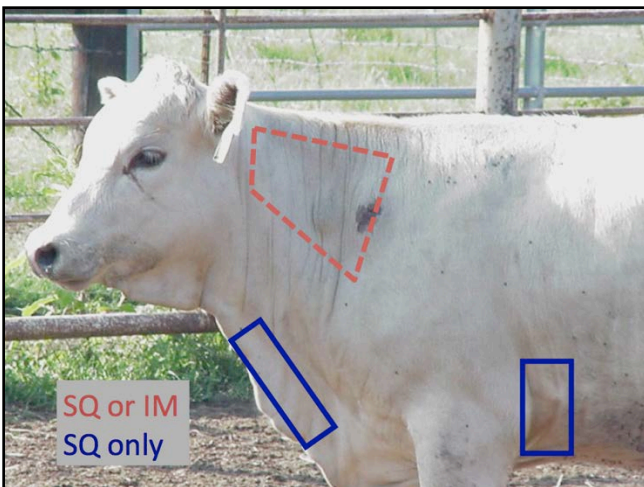

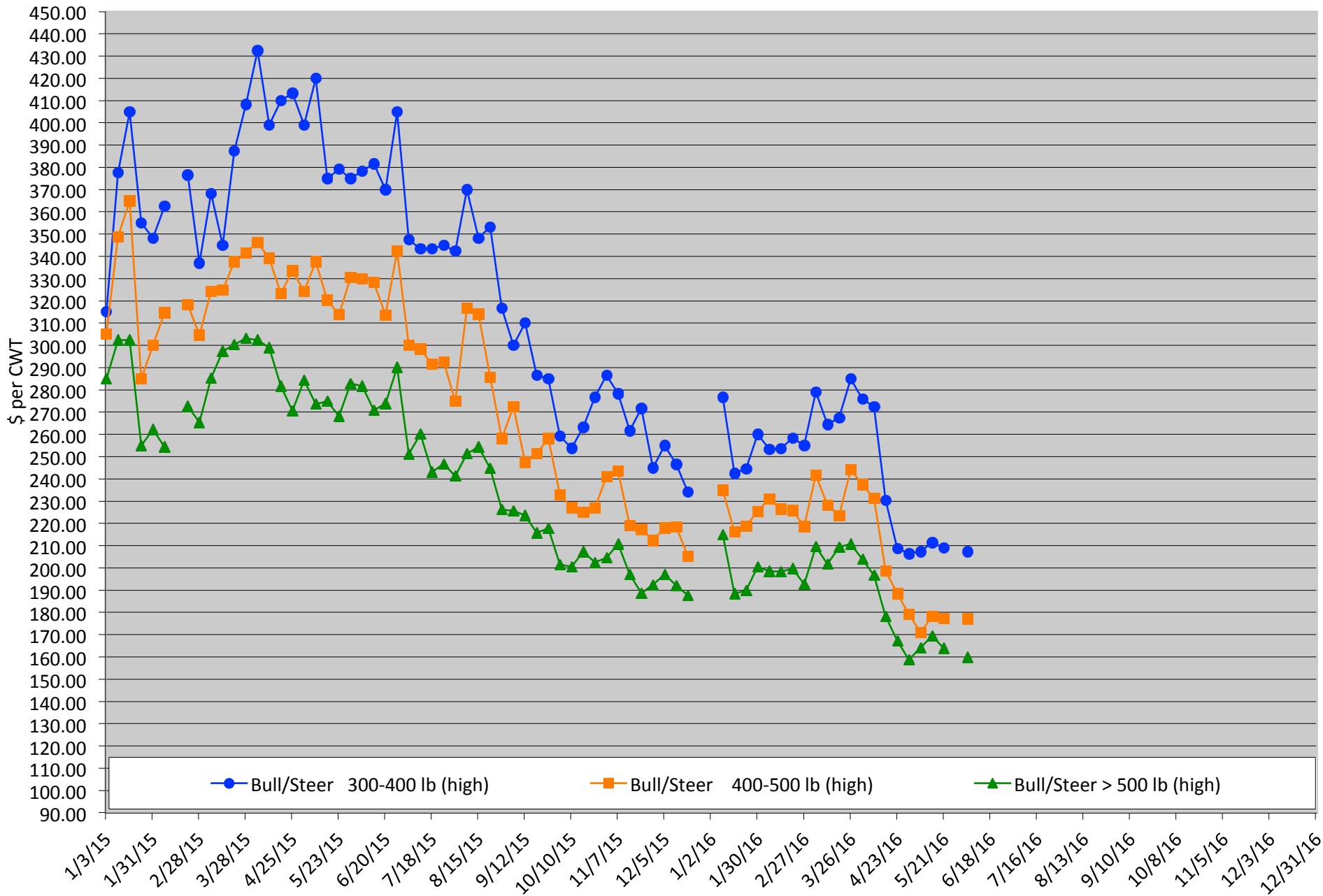

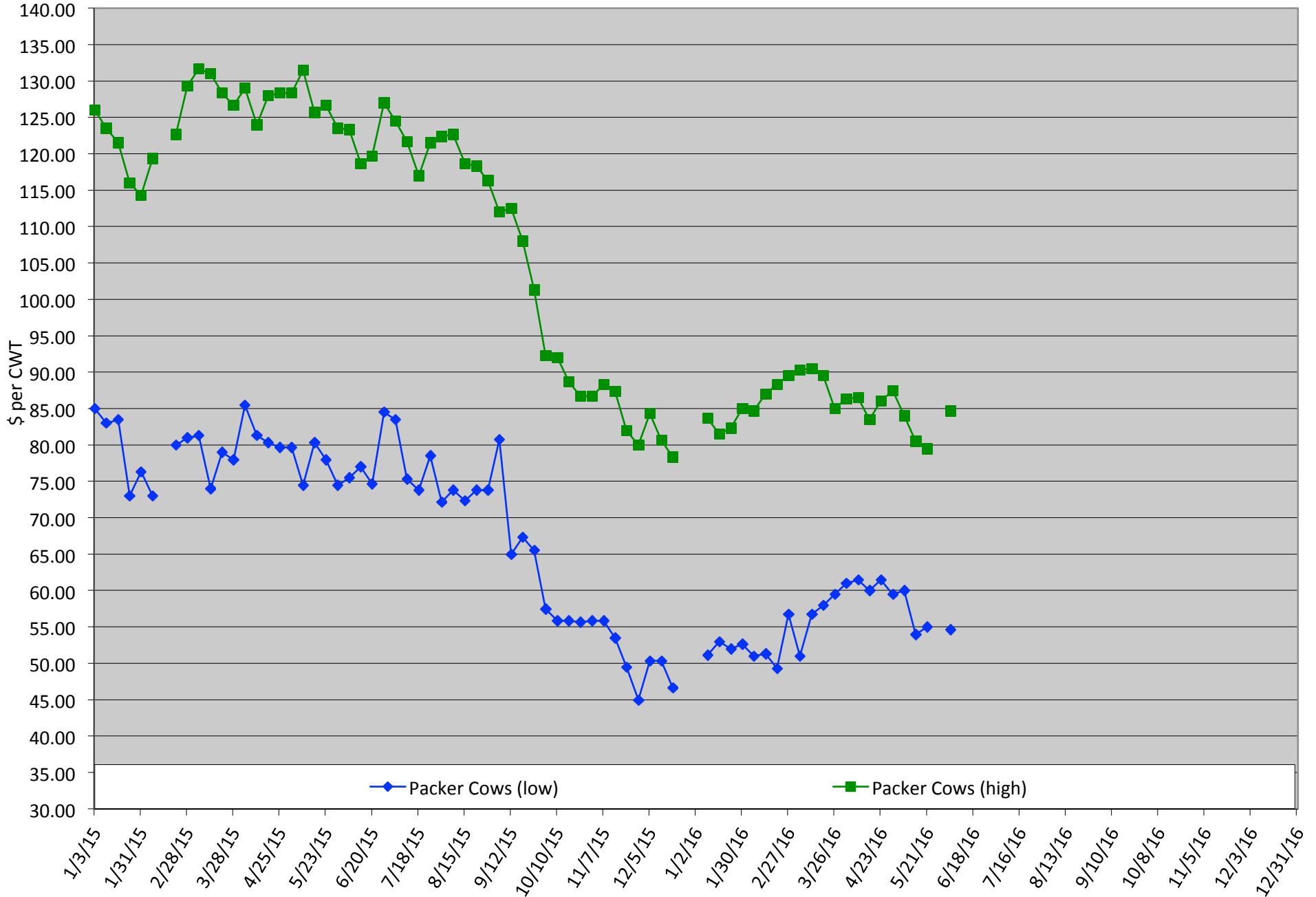


Packer Cow PriceTrends

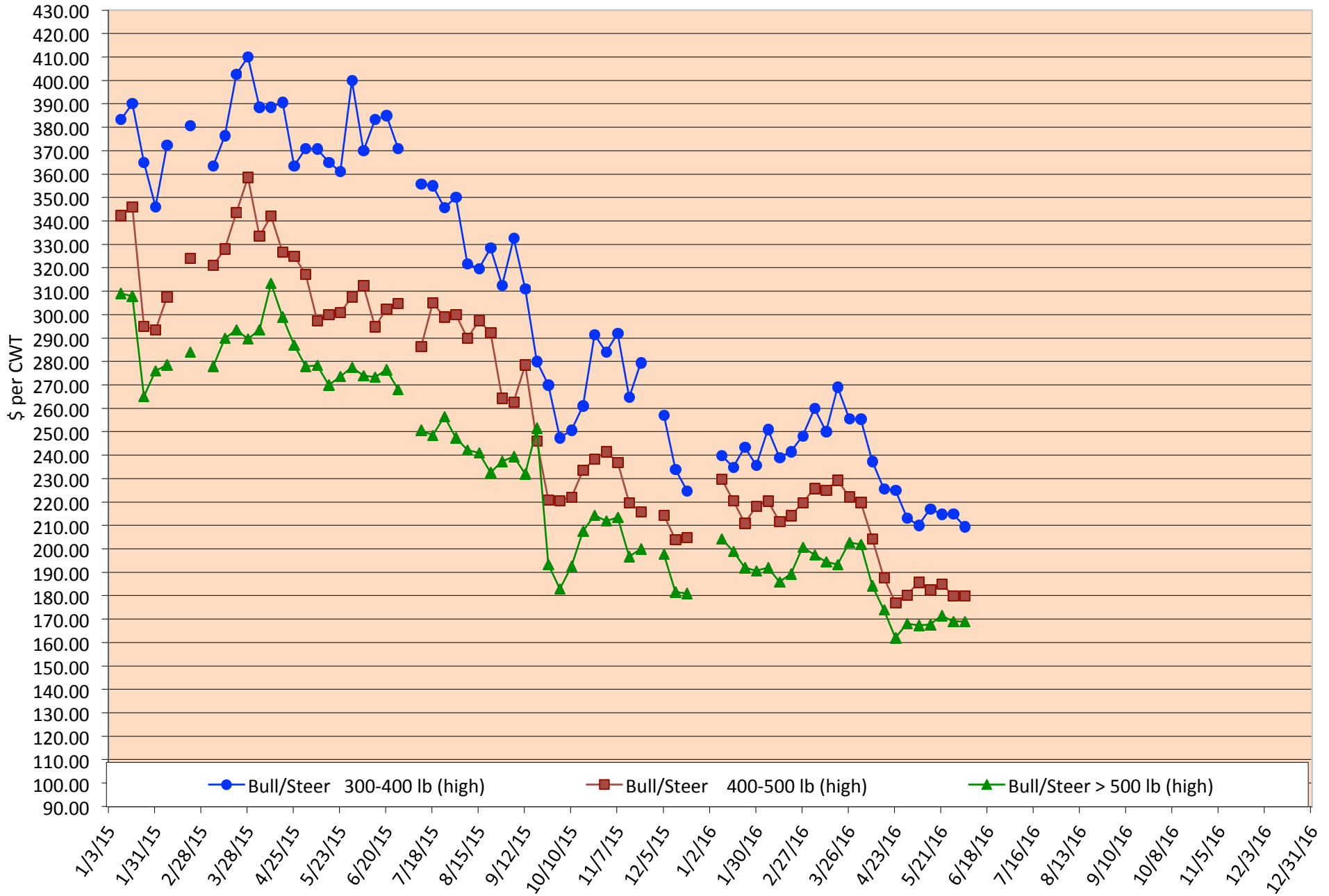
