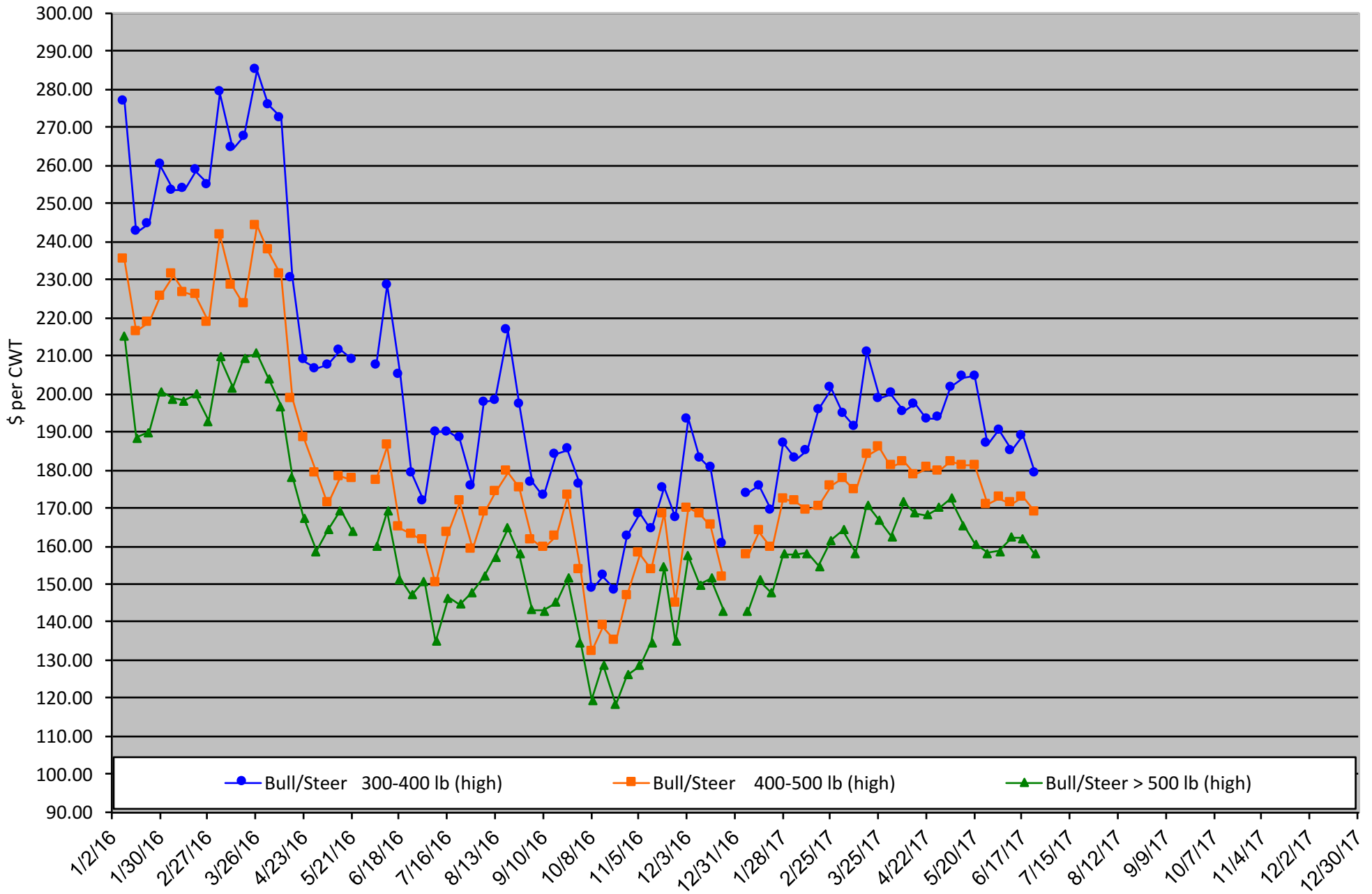

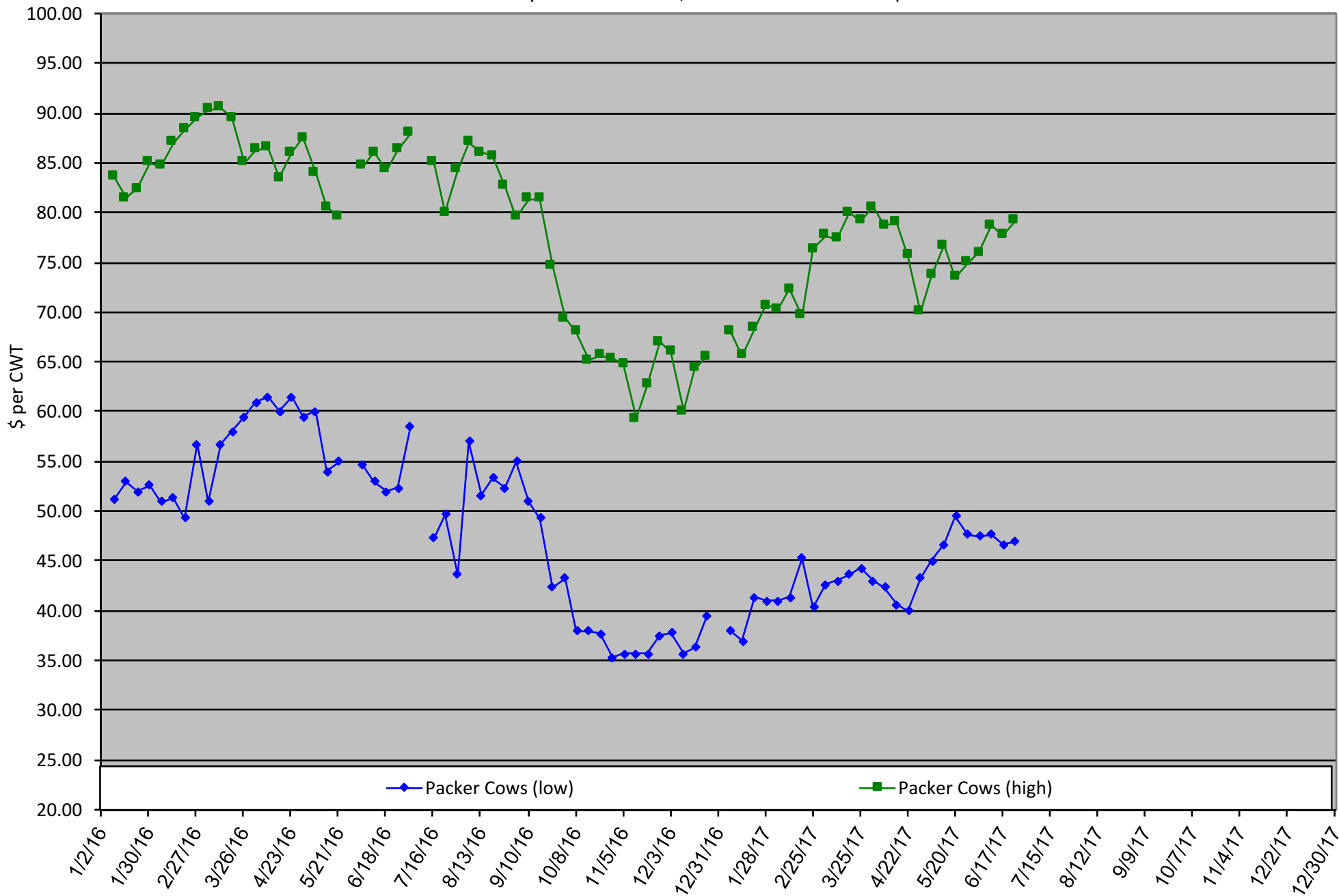


Packer Cow Price Trends

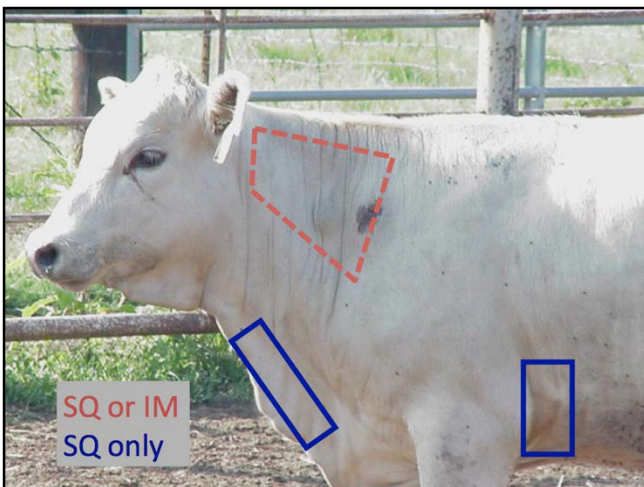

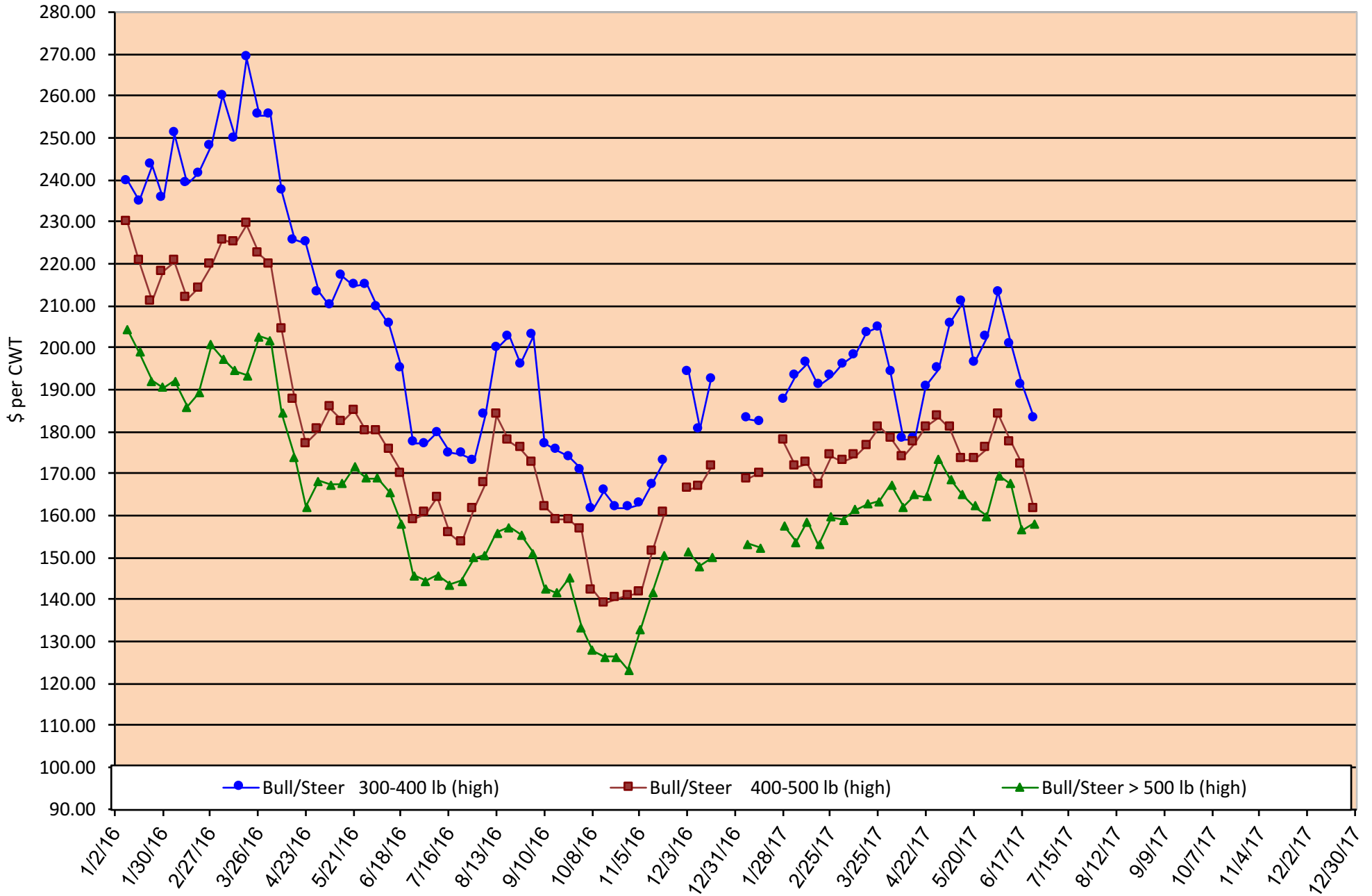
