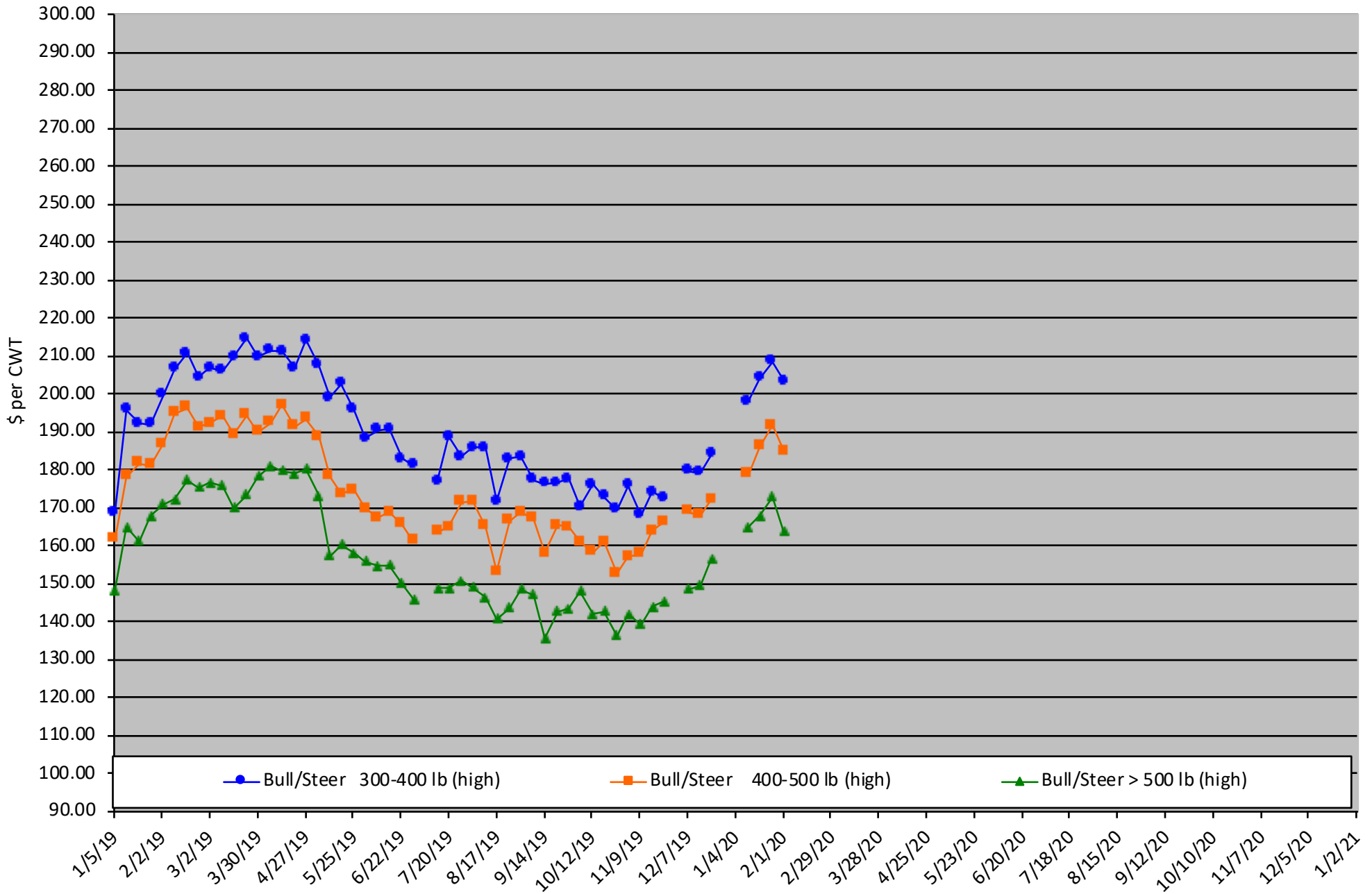

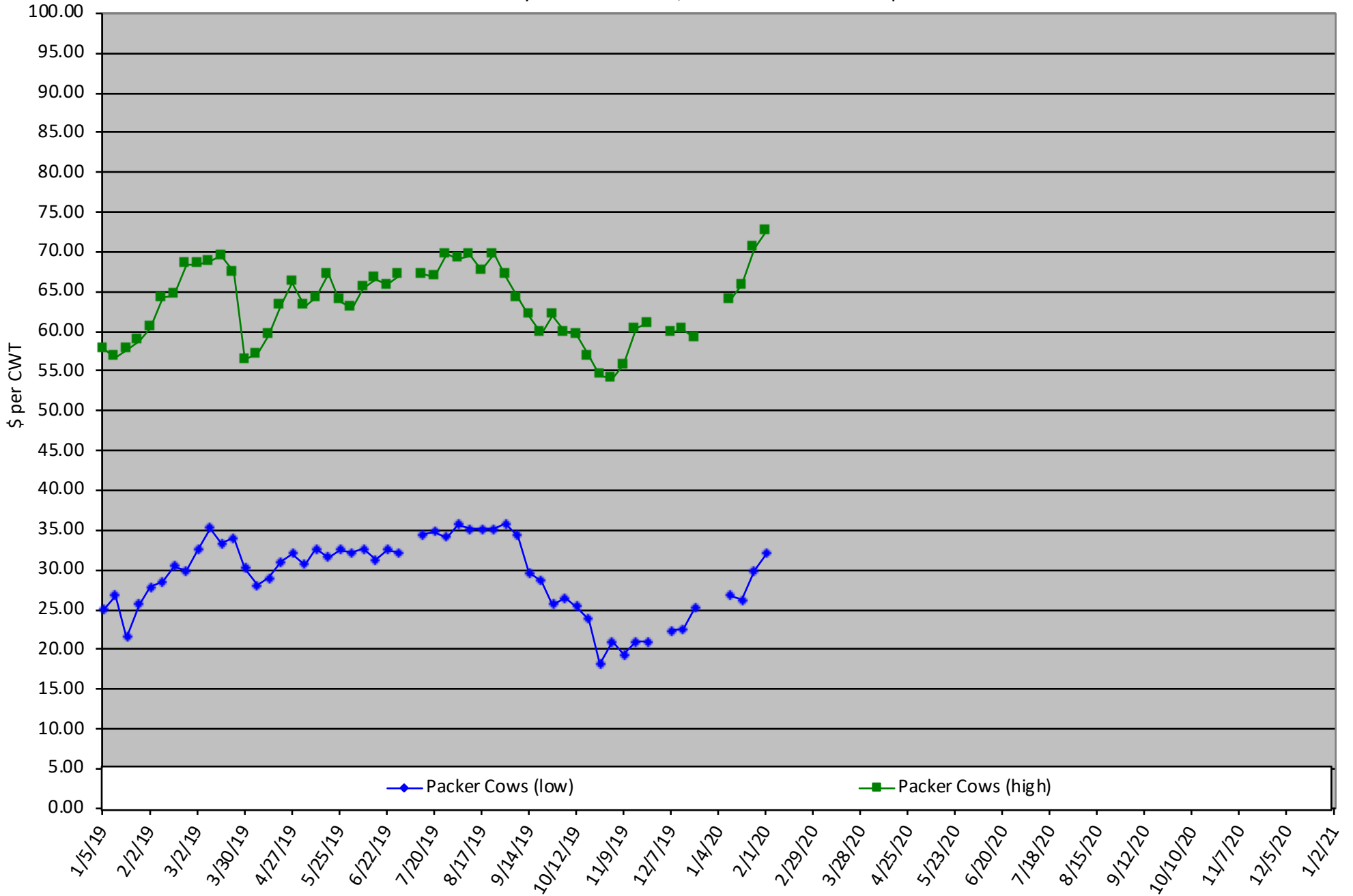


# Packer Cow PriceTrends
